"What a nice dress! This is my EID dress!! I am very happy!" exclaimed Munni. Munni is three years old child; she lives in the Noa Para slum, under the Dhakkhin Khan union, Dhaka. Among her one brother and two sisters she is the second child of her family. Her father is a rickshaw puller and mother is a house helper their economic condition is low.

Munni was one of twenty lucky children to have received used outfits in September. These used items of clothing were kindly donated to SOHAY by a Bangladeshi family for distribution to the under-privileged children living in slum areas before the EID.

Please note, more than half of the total population in Bangladesh live



below the poverty line; a proportion of them live in the urban slums in Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh. The inhabitants of these slums are economically vulnerable. Most families struggle to provide two meals a day for their family let alone adequate clothing for their children. Most children only have one set of clothes.

SOHAY is always speaks for the benefits of the slum families. Most of the children living in slums have never received an EID gift. These old garments make the children feel special and loved.
